EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING CREDITS

Experiential Learning Credits (ELC's) may be granted to enrolled students who meet the required parameters. Students will provide a chronological resume of all their Christian service and secular employment (work-life experience) from 18 years of age. A written or oral exam may be required in a particular subject area before Experiential Learning Credits are approved. Ordinarily, no ELC's will be approved for students under 30 years of age, nor will the maximum number of approved ELC's exceed 25% of the credits required by BBCC & TS for a diploma or degree. For Master or Doctoral degrees, the 25% limit for ELC credits will only be calculated on required course work. Credits for thesis, dissertation, project, or special projects will be exempt from the ELC calculation limit.

Examples:

For an Associate of Religious Education or Associate of Theology Diploma, a maximum of 16 approved ELC's may be applied.

For a Graduate of Religious Education or a Graduate of Theology Diploma, a maximum of 24 approved ELC's may be applied.

For a Bachelor of Religious Education Degree or a Bachelor of Theology Degree, a maximum of 32 approved ELC's may be applied.

For an MRE or DRE degree a maximum of 9 approved ELC's may be applied.

Final approval for ELC's granted by the college toward any given degree or diploma program will be made only after payment for such (non-refundable \$15.00 administrative fee* per credit) is received. This payment must be made within 60 days after a student's work-life experience evaluation has been prepared and presented to the student. ELC's will not receive final approval if the student fails to meet these requirements. ELC's will not formerly appear on a student's transcript until all other degree/diploma requirements for graduation through BBCC & TS are completed.

The evaluation of a student's work-life experience can only commence after all official secondary school, college, and university transcripts, are received along with supporting documentation and a chronological resume. Application for ELC's must be made within 6 months of a student commencing course work with BBCC & TS.

NOTES:

Those who feel they may possibly qualify for ELC's should contact BBCC & TS for further details on how to prepare a biographical/chronological resume.

The administrative fee is \$15.00 per credit in U.S. funds for students living outside of Canada.
