Programs of Study

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS OF STUDY

Certificates:

- ❖ 1 year Bible Certificate

For a certificate, all grades must be a PASS or above, and have a grade point average of at least 0.5.

Diplomas:

- ❖ 2 year Associate of Theology Diploma
- ❖ 2 year Associate of Religious Education Diploma
- ❖ 3 year Graduate of Theology Diploma
- ❖ 3 year Graduate of Religious Education Diploma

Degrees:

- ❖ 4 year Bachelor of Theology Degree (B.Th.)
- ❖ 4 year Bachelor of Religious Education Degree (B.R.E.)

For a Diploma or a Bachelor's Degree, all grades must be in a D category or above and have a grade point average of at least 2.0. Since the academic level of work required for a Diploma is the same as that for an Undergraduate Degree, students having graduated with a Baptist Bible College Canada diploma may have the credits from the Diploma credited towards an Undergraduate Degree at BBCC & TS.

NOTES:

- All 1 year programs require a minimum of 32 credits.
- All 2 year programs require a minimum of 64 credits.
- All 3 year programs require a minimum of 96 credits.
- All 4 year programs require a minimum of 128 credits.

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GRADUATE PROGRAM OF STUDY

Baptist Bible College and Theological Seminary currently offers two graduate degrees:

- ❖ Master of Religious Education Degree (M.R.E.)
- ❖ Master of Theology Degree (M.Th.)

Acceptance for either the M.R.E. or M.Th. degrees is determined by a combination of factors which include:

1. Have an acceptable Bachelor Degree or equivalency which clearly indicates the applicant's ability to succeed at Master level work.
2. Possess a strong Christian character.
3. Have significant experience in successful Christian service of 3 years minimum as a pastor, evangelist, missionary, or teacher.
4. Have a whole hearted acceptance of the doctrinal position of Baptist Bible College Canada and Theological Seminary.

The student must successfully complete a minimum of 36 hours of Master level credits. Any student who plans to proceed with Doctoral study at BBCC & TS must also complete an acceptable thesis (60 to 75 pages) on a preapproved topic. The thesis is equal to an additional 6 hours of credit. All grades must be C category or above with a grade point average of at least 2.75.

NOTES: In place of the thesis an acceptable project (or projects) may be approved.

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POSTGRADUATE PROGRAM OF STUDY

Baptist Bible College and Theological Seminary currently offers two graduate degrees:

- ❖ Doctor of Religious Education Degree (D.R.E.)
- ❖ Doctor of Theology Degree (Th.D.)

Acceptance for the D.R.E. or TH.D degrees is determined by a combination of factors which include:

1. Have an acceptable Master Degree or equivalency which clearly indicates the applicant's ability to successfully manage doctoral level work. Additional study may be required to make up any deficiencies.
2. Possess above average Christian character and conviction.
3. Have significant experience in successful Christian service (3 years minimum) as a Pastor, Evangelist, Missionary, or as a teacher.
4. Have a wholehearted acceptance of the doctrinal position of Baptist Bible College Canada and Theological Seminary.

Requirements:

D.R.E. = 45 credits consisting of 36 credit hours of course work and the submission of a dissertation on a preapproved topic. (Minimum of 150 pages).
(As a Second Degree = 15 credits + 9 credit dissertation)

TH.D. = 60 credits consisting of 51 credit hours of course work and the submission of a dissertation on a preapproved topic. (Minimum of 240 pages).
(As a Second Degree = 21 credits + 9 credit dissertation)

In addition, all grades must be B category or above with a grade point average of at least 3.25.

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
